Student Artwork Guidelines:

- Students should create a 2D artwork imagining what you think Florida's Capitol building/s will look like in the year 2058.
- Each school must select on the best three (3) entries to be displayed. All students receive a certificate of participation.
- Work can focus on the architectural elements of the current buildings, both historic and current Capitols, or can be more abstract.
- Art must be 2-dimensional, unframed, 8.5"x11" and on a surface no thicker than canvas board.
- Can be mixed media, paint, colored pencil, pastel, etc.
- All works must contain:
 - Title
 - Artist name and county
 - School name and teacher name

2. A postage paid envelope will be sent to you for mailing your **TOP 3** selected artworks. Envelopes will be mailed out up until **November 10**. They will include:
 - a. Information on old and current Capitol buildings
 - b. Resource list
 - c. Release forms
 - d. Artwork labels
3. Selected artworks must be postmarked by **November 28**.
4. Gallery Dates: January 12, 2018 – May 1, 2018.
5. Participating students will receive their artwork back, along with a certificate of participation.
